Frequently Asked Questions

What does the Temple do with our dues?

Annual membership dues sustain our institution and allow us to provide programs and services. Dues are our primary source of operational income. Your financial support helps us focus on the ethical and moral teaching of our tradition and makes it possible for the Temple to be a place of strength, comfort, rootedness and inspiration.

What is the Patrons Program?

Our Patrons provide enhanced support beyond standard dues. Their generosity, over and above dues, enhances Temple programs and services not covered by the general operating budget. Our Patrons are sustaining members who make an investment in our future and help guarantee Jewish continuity. There are four levels of enhanced giving: Gibor, Chesed, Tzedek, and Chai Patrons. At each level, Patron members receive tangible benefits for their support. See accompanying brochure.

We cannot afford the full dues.

Is financial assistance available?

No one is denied membership for an inability to pay full dues. Please contact the Executive Director to discuss an adjustment. School families may apply through www.factstuitionaid.com.

Can we pay our annual dues in installments?

Yes. Please make prior arrangements with our Accounting Department. School families must abide by individual school contract agreements.

Do we receive High Holydays tickets with our membership?

You receive one adult ticket per member by submitting an annual High Holydays Ticket Request Form. Members also receive one ticket for each child, ages nine through twenty-four. If a member needs additional tickets for children, they may be purchased in accordance with our High Holydays Guest Ticket policy.

What is the Building Fund?

Temple Israel asks all members to contribute to our Building Fund which pays for major expenditures, repairs and capital improvements. This one-time fee is \$2,000, payable over your first five years of membership. (We gratefully accept additional donations to this fund.)

Are there other fees?

Dues do not cover all the costs of operating the Temple. There are additional fees for participation in Religious School, Bar/Bat Mitzvah training, Nursery School, Day School or Social Hall rental.

ARZA (The Association of Reform Zionists of America) is our Reform movement's representative in the World Zionist Organization and advocates for the principles of democracy, human rights, and religious pluralism in the State of Israel. ARZA is our American vehicle to support our growing progressive movement in the Jewish State as well as the important Israel Religious Action Center, a legal and political lobbying organization dedicated to ARZA's principles. As members of Temple Israel of Hollywood, we are automatically members of ARZA, as well. From time to time, we will receive educational material about our Israeli movement and Reform Zionism. Every four years each of us will have the opportunity to vote in the World Zionist Congress elections where, currently, ARZA is the largest representative slate among all Zionist organizations around the world.
